



Suggested Personal Equipment Checklist

REQUIRED ITEMS:

- UNIFORM SHIRT
 - HAT
 - UNDERGARMENTS (2-3 changes)
 - SOCKS (2-3 changes)
 - WEB BELT AND BUCKLE
 - 3 HOLE, LINED PAPER & NOTEBOOK
 - BALLPOINT PENS, PENCILS
 - SHIRTS, SHORTS, and/or PANTS

 - CANTEEN or WATER BOTTLE
 - SWEATER OR JACKET & SWEATSHIRT

 - HANDKERCHIEFS/KLEENIX (as needed)
 - PAJAMAS/SWEAT SUIT

 - PERSONAL FIRST AID KIT (if desired)
 - TOWEL and WASH CLOTH
 - SUNBURN LOTION/LIP SALVE
 - HAND SOAP AND CONTAINER
 - TOOTH BRUSH AND PASTE
 - SHAVING GEAR
 - OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS as needed
 - COMPASS
 - DAY PACK OR BOOK BAG
- REQUIRED/PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS
(in original labeled containers)
 - MIRROR (metal)
 - COMB
 - SHOES SUITABLE FOR HIKING
 - CHANGE OF SHOES

 - ALARM CLOCK
 - RAINCOAT OR PONCHO *(Activities will go on in all kinds of weather)*
 - INSECT REPELLENT **(no aerosols)**
 - SLEEPING BAG (liner)
 - EXTRA BLANKET *(if desired)*
 - AIR MATTRESS/FOAM PAD
 - FLASHLIGHT (spare batteries, bulbs)
 - SAFETY PINS

 - ROPE for knot tying practice
 - CAMERA AND EXTRA FILM/Memory Card
 - SCOUT KNIFE (no belt clips)
(no sheath knives)
 - SCOUT HANDBOOK (newest edition)
 - MERIT BADGE REQUIREMENTS BOOK

- LONG SLEEVED SHIRTS
- SUNGLASSES
- EXTRA PRESCRIPTION GLASSES
- RELIGIOUS TEXT
- WATCH

- PILLOW, PILLOW CASE

- BOY SCOUT FIELDBOOK
